

# Let's Get Organized!

In Language Arts and Social Studies you will need to bring to class everyday a **3-ring binder with FIVE dividers** that you will use to organize your work. Below you will find a list of how you should organize and label those four dividers and what type of work will be located in each section.

NOTE: In addition to bringing your organized binder, in Language Arts you must also bring a **COMPOSITION BOOK** every single day for journal writing and reading responses.

## LANGUAGE ARTS (3-ring notebook dividers)

- **LA - Reading**
  - reading activities/book reviews/reading responses
  - personal monthly reading log
  
- **LA - Writing**
  - writing practice activities
  - outlines/first drafts/revisions
  - Weekly Word Studies/personal spelling list
  
- **LA - Daily Work**
  - daily activities/handouts/worksheets, etc.

### Composition Notebook for Language Arts:

- journal/warm-up entries
- reading responses
- notes

## SOCIAL STUDIES (3-ring notebook dividers)

- **SS - Tests/Quizzes**
  - review sheets
  - previous/returned tests and quizzes
  
- **SS - Daily Work**
  - in-class handouts/worksheets
  - notes from powerpoints or movies
  - homework/previous homework packets
